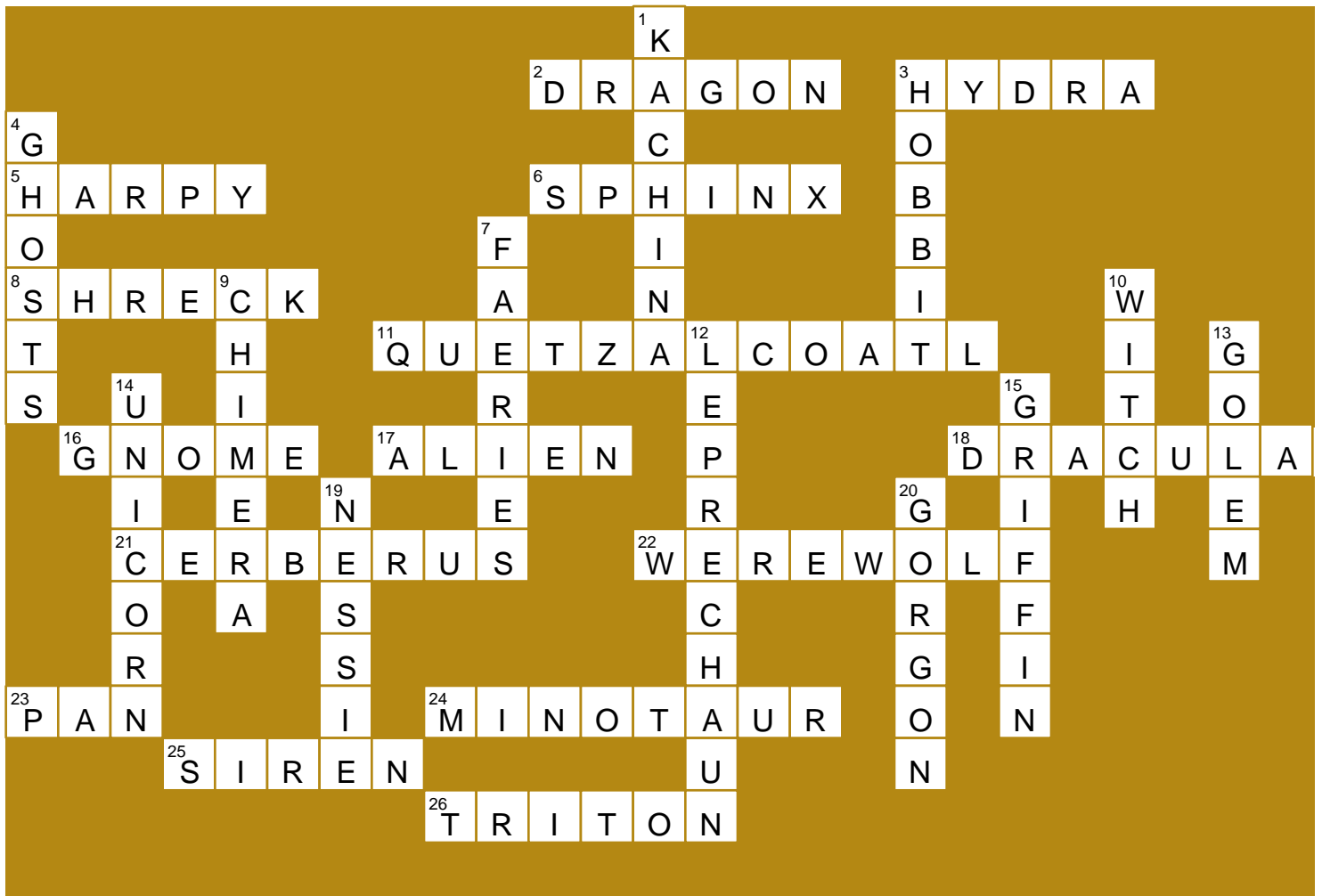


Phenomenal Creatures
