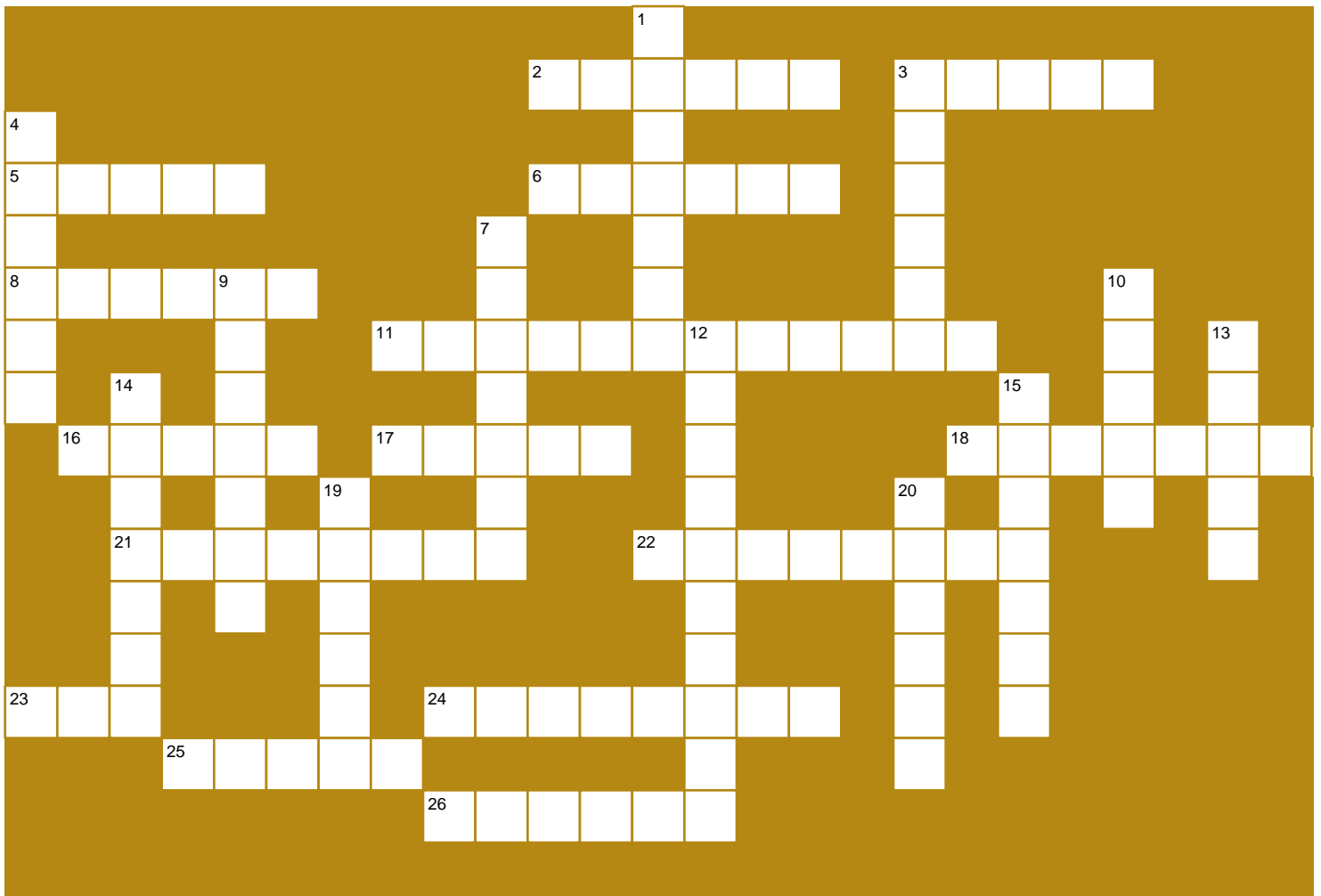


Phenomenal Creatures
